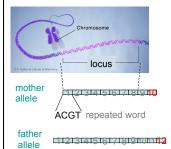

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DNA genotype



A genetic locus has two DNA sentences, one from each parent.

An allele is the number of repeated words.

A genotype at a locus is a pair of alleles. 10, 12

Many alleles allow for many many allele pairs. A person's genotype

is relatively unique.

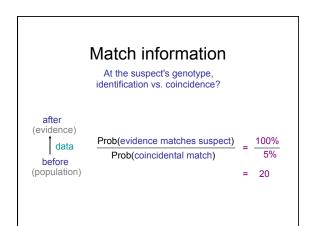


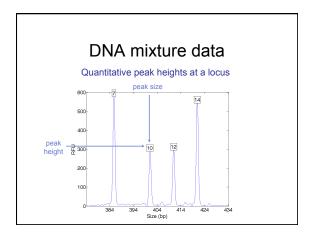


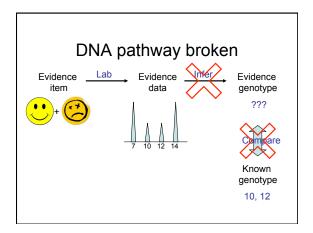


Known genotype

Human interpretation issues

- Evidence call good data inconclusive
- peaks are too low for them
- too many contributors to handle
- potential examination bias

- <u>Database</u>hit by association, not by match
- comparison: make false hits
 restrict upload: lose true hits

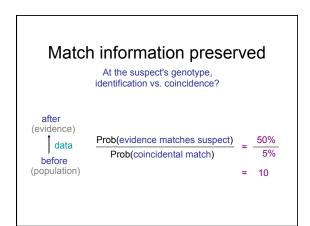
TrueAllele® Casework

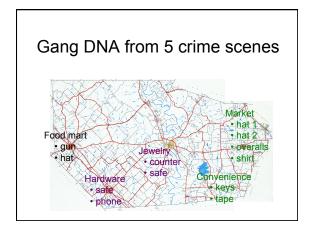
- Evidence preserve data information
- use all peaks, high or low

Database

- hit based on LR match statistic
- sensitive: find true hits
 specific: only true hits

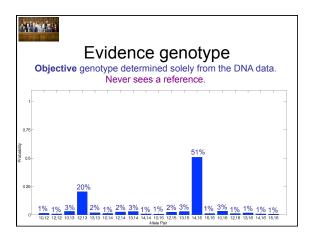


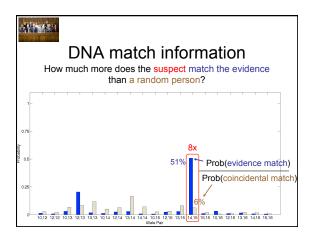


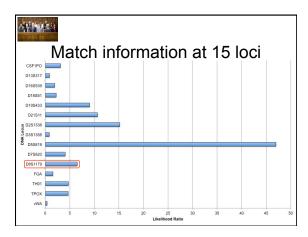














Is the suspect in the evidence?

A match between the front counter and Dupree Langston is:

553 million times more probable than a coincidental match to an unrelated Black person

731 million times more probable than a coincidental match to an unrelated Caucasian person

208 million times more probable than a coincidental match to an unrelated Hispanic person

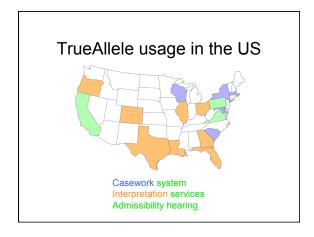

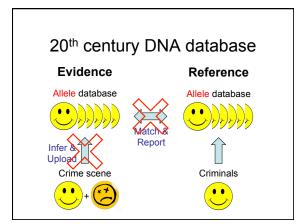

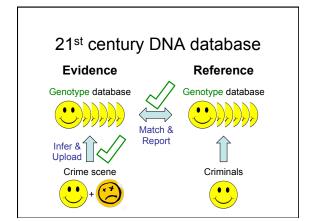
