

WRIT GRANTED; RELIEF DENIED: Defendant filed a writ application with this court seeking supervisory review of the trial court's June 2, 2023 ruling denying the defense's "Motion to Preclude State's Evidence of TrueAllele DNA Probabilistics Genotyping Results." After a review of the arguments, evidence, law, and relevant jurisprudence, this court finds no abuse of the trial court's discretion. *See* La.Code Evid. arts. 403, 702-05; La.R.S. 15:441.1; *Old Chief v. 
